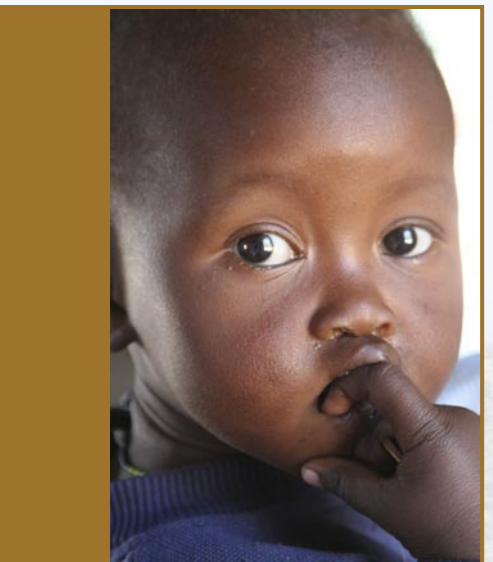


WE VISITED THE REMOTE NUBA MOUNTAINS.

“CUT THE CRAP AND MAKE IT HAPPEN”.

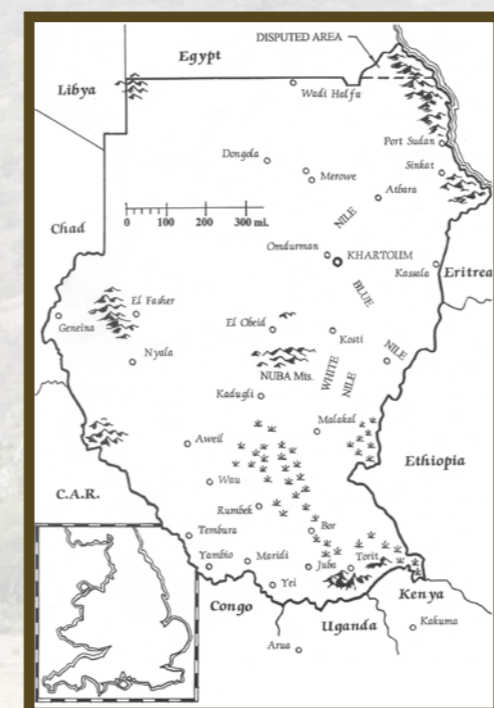


HOW TO MAKE IT HAPPEN...

WE BELIEVE EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO AN EDUCATION...

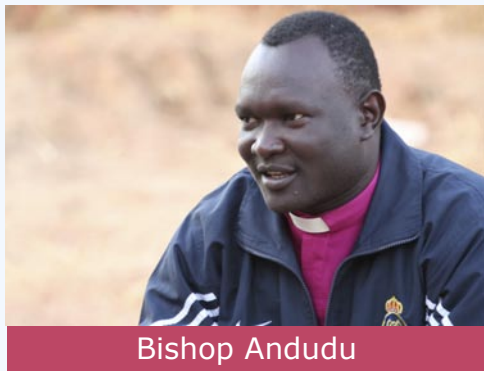
